DESCRIPTION

The Gates Scholarship (TGS) is a highly selective, last-dollar scholarship for outstanding, minority, high school seniors from low-income households. Each year, the scholarship is awarded to 300 of these student leaders, with the intent of helping them realize their maximum potential.

BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

A high school senior from at least one of the following ethnicities: African-American, American Indian/Alaska Native*, Asian & Pacific Islander American, and/or Hispanic American. Student must be Pell-eligible and a US citizen, national, or permanent resident who is in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA

of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent). Additionally, a student must plan to enroll fulltime, in a four-year degree program, at a US accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university.

*For American Indian/Alaska Native, proof of tribal enrollment will be required.
